The Mission of Mercy Program has been run in several other states, and in just one weekend, the group served well over 1,000 people with free dental care! The dentists, dental hygienists, dental assistants, etc. all work together to provide cleanings, fillings, and extractions to those in need.

This year is the first year for the program here in Connecticut. It will be held in the Old Tolland High School. Volunteer hours are on: **Friday**, April 11th from **7:30AM-5PM Saturday**, April 12th from **5AM-5PM** (orientation is at 4:30AM) **Sunday**, April 13th from **5AM-12noon** (orientation is at 4:30AM) and from **noon to 5PM** for breaking down all the equipment
